WHEREAS, in this great land of ours we are fortunate enough to be able to send food to starved people in other parts of the world, and

WHEREAS, the Christian Rural Overseas Program has been functioning for the past 12 years as a powerful instrument for spreading good will throughout the world, and

WHEREAS, CROP demonstrates that democracy in action has as its foundation the welfare of the individual, and

WHEREAS, the month of November, with its traditional Thanksgiving holiday, is a particularly appropriate time to show our gratitude to God by sharing our plenty with those less fortunate;

I, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the state of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, November 8, 1959 as

State CROP Sunday

and November 8 - 14, 1959, as

State CROP Week
