National Catholic Youth Week

WHEREAS, young people ought to develop a strong moral character, a spirit of patriotism, and a sense of responsibility in order to carry out this trust, and

WHEREAS, seven million young Americans who take part in the Catholic Youth program work together to insure these goals, and

WHEREAS, youth must prize the power of spiritual motivation, and

WHEREAS, spirituality is a source of vitality and this is aptly summarized in the theme "SPIRITUATED YOUTH-VITALIZING DATES", Now,

I, THEREFORE, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 25 - November 1, 1959, as

CATHOLIC YOUTH WEEK

and urge all to acknowledge the outstanding contribution made by the Catholic Church to Youth programs and to assist in every way possible the promotion of this worthwhile endeavor.
