National Catholic Youth Week

- WHEREAS, the future of our country and of the world depends upon youth, and,
- WHEREAS, young people ought to develop a strong moral character, a spirit of patriotism, and a sense of responsibility in order to carry out this trust, and
- WHEREAS, seven million young Americans who take part in the Catholic Youth programs work together to insure these goals, and
- WHEREAS, youth must prize the power of spiritual motivation, and
- WHEREAS, spirituality is a source of vitality and this is aptly summarized in the theme "SPIRITFULNESS YOUTH-VITALIZES NATIONS",

I, THEREFORE, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the state of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 25 - November 1, 1959, as

CATHOLIC YOUTH WEEK

and urge all to acknowledge the outstanding contribution made by the Catholic Church's Youth programs and to assist in every way possible the promotion of this patriotic endeavor.
