Re: Savage Annexation Matter

Dear Miss Dion:

Ordinance No. 56 of the Village of Savage, being one for annexation of property and passed on the 28th day of September, 1959, was passed pursuant to Section 414.03, Subd. 7 of the Minnesota Statutes, being Chapter 686 of the laws of 1959, and a Petition for Annexation to the Village of Savage, and signed by all of the owners of the property lying adjacent to and abutting on the Village of Savage, and the property was under 200 acres of land (being in fact, approximately 3 acres).

It appears that the Ordinance when adopted was pursuant to the above Section of the Law, and copies thereof have been filed with the County Auditor, the Municipalities Commission, and now with your office, as provided by the said law.

I trust this statement will bring the Ordinance as passed more clarity for the purposes of filing in your office.

ORDINANCE NO. 56,  
AN ORDINANCE FOR ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY

The Village Council of the Village of Savage do ordain:

WHEREAS, it appears that a Petition for the Annexation of certain real property to the Village of Savage has been duly and properly presented to this Body, and

WHEREAS, the matter has been thoroughly studied by this Body,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Council of the Village of Savage does hereby find that it is in the best interests of the Village of Savage, and of the territory to be annexed that it be annexed, and

The Village Council of the Village of Savage does hereby annex to the Village of Savage, the following described property:

Beginning at a point twenty-eight (28) feet North of the Southwest corner of Section 31, Township 27, Range 24; which point is on the West line of said section; thence East seven hundred fifty (750) feet to a point southwesterly twenty-six (26) feet from the centerline of the Minneapolis Northfield, and Southern Railroad track; thence N 42°-11'-40"W, parallel to said centerline, two hundred sixty-seven and twenty-five hundredths (267.25) feet; thence West five hundred seventy and fifty hundredths (570.50) feet, to a point on the West line of said Section 31, said point being two hundred twenty-six (226) feet North of the Southwest corner of said Section 31; thence South one hundred ninety-eight (198) feet to the point of beginning. All of said tract lying in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 31, T 27, R 24, Scott County, Minnesota,

which described property contains three (3) acres of land more or less.

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption and publication according to law.
