

ORDINANCE NO. 53

ORDINANCE ANNEKING ADJOINING LANDS

Be it ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Byron:

That the following described platted and unplatted land abutting the limits of the Village of Byron and not exceeding 200 acres, is hereby added to, taken into and made a part of the Village of Byron:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) in Section 32 of Township 107 North of Range 15 West in Olmsted County Minnesota, lying South of the South right of way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Co. as now located and West of the present limits of the Village of Byron, Minnesota, subject to existing highway easements.

But excepting therefrom the East 633 feet of the South 400 feet of said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 32, Township 107 North of Range 15 West.
