AMENDMENTS

TO

THE CHARTER

of the

CITY OF PIPESTONE,

ADOPTED APRIL 6th, 1915.

Section 19 of said Charter is hereby amended by adding to said section at the end thereof the following proviso: PROVIDED, that when no more than two persons file for the nomination for any one office, their names shall not be placed upon the primary ballot, but said persons shall be considered and shall be the nominees for such office and their names shall be placed upon the general municipal ballot as provided by section 24 of this Charter. PROVIDED, that when no more than two persons file for the nomination for any office, no primary selection shall be held.

Sec. 28. The provisions of the state law relating to the qualifications of elections, preparing the ballots, the manner of voting, the duties of election officers, and in all other particulars in respect to the management of elections, so far as they may be applicable and not inconsistent with the provisions of this Charter, shall govern all such elections:

PROVIDED, the polls shall be kept open from 6-30 o'clock A. M. until 7 O'clock P. M.

Section 70 of said Charter is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 70. The fiscal year of the city shall commence upon the 15th, day of March, of each year, except when such date falls upon Sunday, in which case, it shall begin on the next succeeding business day.
