Diabetes Week

WHEREAS, diabetes - an ailment that often creeps in hidden form - can be detected by means of a simple, painless test that is available to our citizens, and

WHEREAS, early detection and medical care can almost always assure that diabetics will be able to continue to lead normal, active lives, and

WHEREAS, the AMERICAN DIABETES ASSOCIATION, INC., in conducting the 1959 diabetes detection drive in Minnesota to enable our citizens to obtain this test - and be cured, and

WHEREAS, Diabetes Week is sponsored to discover the undiagnosed cases of diabetes and to alert peoples to the symptoms of the ailment,

I, ~~Joseph L. Saravan~~, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 15 - 21, 1959, as Diabetes Week in Minnesota and urge all of our citizens to take full advantage of its opportunities.
