PROCLAMATION

CIVIL DEFENSE DAY


- WHEREAS, the protection of homes and loved ones is of paramount concern to all citizens of Minnesota, and
- WHEREAS, the possibility of attack from nuclear weapons, guided missiles and disasters from natural causes constantly imperil the lives and property of our citizens, and
- WHEREAS, county and municipal governments, augmented by their civil defense organizations throughout the state are an important safeguard against these disasters, and
- WHEREAS, government workers and civil defense volunteers have given freely of their time to aid this vital program and the President of the United States deemed it appropriate that the day of December 7 be set aside as "Preparedness Day" across the Nation.

I, **Frederic E. Caville L. Freeman**, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the day of December 7, 1959, as


CIVIL DEFENSE DAY

and call upon our citizens to mark this day with appropriate ceremonies and participate in local observances.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twelfth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and of the State, the one hundred second.
