Intending the corporate limits of the City of Austin to be as follows:

Whereas all of the owners owning the premises hereinafter described have petitioned the Common Council of Austin, Minnesota, to have the hereinafter described premises annexed to the corporate limits of Austin, Minnesota, and

Whereas said premises situate in the City of Austin and are subject to incorporation within the corporate limits of Austin, Minnesota, by petition to the governing body of the City of Austin, and

Whereas it is to the best interest of the City of Austin and also the premises hereinafter described that said premises be annexed to the City of Austin and said premises are well fitted to be under municipal government and are well adapted for municipal use, and

Whereas the premises hereinafter described desired to be annexed are less than 200 acres and the petition for annexation has been signed by all of the owners of the annexed property.

The Common Council, the governing body of the City of Austin, do hereby order:

#### SECTION 1.

That the land hereinafter described be added to and incorporated within the corporate limits of the City of Austin, Minnesota, and said Common Council does hereby declare said premises hereinafter described to be incorporated within and to be a part of the City of Austin, Minnesota. The premises are described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast Corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 102 North, Range 10 West; thence 330.00' West on 1/16 line of said Northwest Quarter; thence 172.25' North at a deflection angle of 89° 47' right; on west line of Outlet 12 of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, which point hereinafter shall be called the point of beginning; thence 167.61' North on an extension of the last described line; thence 83.0' West at a deflection angle of 90° 02' left; thence 167.60' North at a deflection angle of 90° 02' right; thence 400.87' East at a deflection angle of 90° 03' right; thence 335.1' South at a deflection angle of 89° 03' right; thence 327.04' West at a deflection angle of 90° 55 1/2' right, to the point of beginning, being part of Outlet 11, 12 and 13 in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 102 North, Range 10 West; containing 2,815 Acres, all in Honor County, Minnesota.

#### SECTION 2.

The above described land extending the corporate limits of the City of Austin, Minnesota, shall be added to the end of 2300.63, in the Certification in the regular chronological order.

SECTION 3.

This subscription shall not be final until copies of these ordinances have been filed with the Principal Commissioner of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor of House County, Minnesota.
