

A Proclamation for "A SAFER HOLIDAY SEASON"

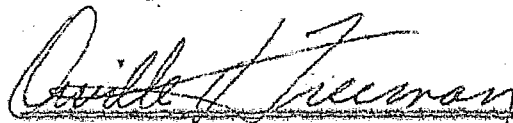
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WHEREAS, during this season of celebration of the birth of the Prince of Peace, the joy that abounds in our people must not be marred by tragedies of injuries and deaths, and

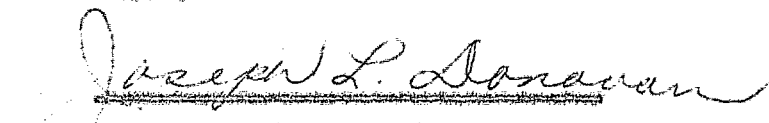
