WHEREAS, the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952 requires every alien in the United States, except diplomats, persons officially connected with international organizations of which the United States is a member, and others admitted temporarily as agricultural laborers, must report his address during January of each year; and

WHEREAS, this law requires such an address report though the address of the alien has not changed since the last address report; and

WHEREAS, Address Report Cards may now be obtained at any United States Post Office or Immigration Service Office,

BEFORE ME, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor, in recognition of the importance of compliance with the law to future citizens of the State of Minnesota, do hereby prescribe the month of January 1960, as

in Minnesota and request all citizens, employers, and officers of the State of Minnesota to assist and encourage every alien within the State of Minnesota to report his address at the nearest Post Office or Immigration Service during the month of January 1960.

BEFORE ME, I have honored and my hand and caused the great seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at St. Paul, the capital, this twenty-second day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine and of the state the one hundred second.
