A PROCLAMATION FOR "MINNESOTA FUTURE FARMER WEEK"

WHEREAS, the success and progress of agriculture in Minnesota has much to contribute to the future of all of the people in our state; and

WHEREAS, the skill, effort, and ability of those citizens who operate the many farms of this state are major factors in bringing about the great future toward which we all aspire; and

WHEREAS, this year marks the 30th anniversary of the Minnesota Association of Future Farmers of America, an organization composed of over 12,500 members who are studying vocational agriculture in 289 secondary schools as preparation for careers in farming and of more than 50,000 former members; and

WHEREAS, the Future Farmers of America helps to teach sound methods of farming, develop leadership and promote good citizenship among its members, who are hereby encouraged to perform valuable community services and to contribute materially toward the development of our agricultural economy and the building of a better state; and

WHEREAS, the youthful members of the Future Farmers of America are going to be leading citizens of Minnesota during the next century;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of February 20 through February 27, 1960 as

"MINNESOTA FUTURE FARMER WEEK"

and urge all citizens to note the many contributions of the Future Farmers to our state and to encourage in every way possible the further growth of this organization for our farm youth.
