PROCLAMATION

National Electrical Week

- WHEREAS, The week of February 7 to 13 has been designated National Electrical Week in recognition of the importance of electricity and the electrical industry to the social and economic strength of our community, state and nation, and;
- WHEREAS, To enhance public awareness of the importance of electrical contributions to our economic well being and of the importance of services provided by electricity in our everyday life, and;
- WHEREAS, To encourage the safe and efficient use of electricity and electrical equipment through safety programs through the state and;
- WHEREAS, The Apprenticeship and Training program is instituted for the purpose of ensuring industrial progress for the apprenticeship electrical youth and advanced training for the journeyman electricians in the industry, and;
- WHEREAS, To pay tribute to all electrical pioneers, typified by Thomas A. Edison, who contributed so much to the development of this vital industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 7 to 13, 1968 as

in Minnesota, and I strongly urge all citizens and organizations to participate in the observance of this significant occasion.
