
WHEREAS, To pay tribute to all electrical pioneers, typified by George A. Edison, who contributed so much to the development of this great industry;

LET THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 7 to 13, 1968 as


NATIONAL ELECTRICAL WEEK
