WHEREAS, William Worm was in the month of November, 1914, murdered in the County of Cass in the State of Minnesota; and,

WHEREAS, the murderer of the said William Worm has not been apprehended and the public welfare requires his capture, conviction, and punishment for said offense; and,

WHEREAS, there is reason to believe that one Bruce Chapman is guilty of the murder of said William Worm;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Winfield S. Hammond, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State the sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for the arrest or for information leading to the arrest of the said Bruce Chapman.
