Chapter No. 9.1

An Ordinance Annexing Certain Adjacent and Abutting Real Property to the Village of Rockford.

That upon the petition of all of the owners of the following described real estate, and it appearing to be for the best interest of the Village of Rockford and of the territory herinafter described, the Village Council of Rockford do ordain:

Section 1. That the following described unplatted real estate, not exceeding 200 acres, and adjacent to and abutting upon the said Village of Rockford, in the County of Wright and State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

The East half of the Southwest Quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), all in section twenty (20), Township one hundred nineteen (119), Range twenty-four (24), containing 120 acres, more or less,

be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Rockford, and shall become a part thereof as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.

Section 2. That the annexation of the territory described above shall be determined final upon filing of a copy of the ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of the State of Minnesota, and the County Auditor of Wright County, Minnesota.
