A PROCLAMATION FOR  
"AMERICAN MUSIC MONTH"

WHEREAS, music is one of the highest expressions of man's creative ability and, through the stimulation of basic human response and appreciation, promotes understanding and the brotherhood of all men; and  
WHEREAS, the music of the American composer has gained renown for its creative force and expressiveness of the American society; and  
WHEREAS, for the eighth consecutive year, the National Federation of Music Clubs is staging its annual "Parade of American Music" in February, with its goal the presentation of at least 5,000 all-American programs during the month.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1960 to

"AMERICAN MUSIC MONTH"

and urge all clubs, schools and districts to recognize the American composer in their program planning during February.
