

STATEMENT OF THE SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL SYSTEM

- First, the School Safety Patrol System in Minnesota protects the children in all of our schools in a most effective manner and
- Second, the rolls of the School Safety Patrols have reached nearly 30,000 young volunteers who perform a vital public service in guarding their comrades from the hazards of traffic and other dangers; and
- Third, these youngsters receive such enjoyment from working and other improvements in order to fulfill their assignments with great courage and loyalty, to the point where no traffic fatality has ever been charged to the program; and
- Fourth, the operation of the School Safety Patrol System in Minnesota has brought great credit to the state including a citation awarded from the National Safety Council; and
- Fifth, it is fitting that we should not withhold a special line for tribute to the boys and girls who have served so faithfully in the past and are serving so well today and encourage others to extend to these youngsters the appreciation they deserve for their contributions to Minnesota's safety.

FOR TRANSMIT, I, Charles L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week beginning February 15, 1960 as

"SCHOOL SAFETY WEEK, 1960"

as a means of recognizing and encouraging the important work of the School Safety Patrols in Minnesota.
