PROCLAMATION

1960 CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK

WHEREAS, the health, appearance and well-being of our children and youth are greatly affected by the condition of the teeth and mouth; and,

WHEREAS, more than 95 per cent of our population suffer from tooth decay or other dental disease at some in their lives; and,

WHEREAS, early preventive measures can protect our children from a large part of these dental diseases, especially tooth decay, and can help insure good dental health in adulthood;

NOW THEREFORE, I, *Gervillio L. Freeman*, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of February 7 through February 13, 1960 as,

CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK

and urge that all officials and all community organizations join in the observance.
