PROCLAMATION

1960 GROWTH'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK

- WHEREAS, the health, appearance and well-being of our children and youth are greatly affected by the condition of the teeth and mouths and,
- WHEREAS, more than 95 per cent of our population suffer from tooth decay or other dental disease at some time in their lives; and,
- WHEREAS, early preventive measures can protect our children from a large part of these dental disorders, especially tooth decay, and can help insure good dental health in adulthood;

BE IT THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of February 7 through February 13, 1960 as,

GROWTH'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK

and urge that all citizens and all community organizations join in this observance.
