A PROCLAMATION FOR "MINNESOTA TEEN-AGE SAFE DRIVING ROAD-O-O WEEK"

- WHEREAS, education of our drivers is our greatest hope for dealing successfully with the growing problem of man and the motor vehicle,
- WHEREAS, the youthful drivers of the State of Minnesota are a very important factor in our efforts to make our highways safe and should be taught and encouraged to practice safe driving,
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Junior Chamber of Commerce has recognized the need to help, in a tangible way, the driver educators combat the traffic accidents and violations,
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Junior Chamber of Commerce, in recognition of this need, has developed the Safe Driving Road-o-o, which through driver education courses and written driving tests seek to encourage, foster and stimulate a safe driving attitude,
- WHEREAS, the Safe Driving Road-o-o is open to all young drivers who are unmarried, between the ages of 16 to 19 years and have a drivers license. Recognition of outstanding young drivers is made through awarding of college scholarships,

FOR THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 14th through May 21st, 1960 as,

"MINNESOTA TEEN-AGE DRIVING ROAD-O-O WEEK"

and call upon every citizen to enthusiastically support this important safety project.
