

A PROCLAMATION FOR "B" DAY

WHEREAS, the good works of the Women's Auxiliary of Mount Sinai Hospital have contributed to the improved climate for public support of charitable services in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the Mount Sinai Free Bed Fund, supported by the Women's Auxiliary, enables many persons to receive free medical and surgical care, regardless of race, color or creed; and




