RESOLUTION DISSOLVING TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, a resolution by the Town Board of Grand Park Township, certifying that an election was held in Grand Park Township on June 8, 1959 on the question- "Shall Grand Park Township, which is more particularly described as Township One Hundred Forty (140) Range Thirty-nine (39) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Becker County, Minnesota be dissolved?" and certifying that there were thirteen (13) yes votes cast and one (1) no vote cast, has been presented to the County Board,

AND, WHEREAS, the County Board recognizes the fact that the tax base of the township has been greatly reduced by the acquisition of lands for the Tamarac Game Refuge and that the cost of supporting a township government has become a financial burden on the remaining tax payers,

NOW, THEN BE IT RESOLVED, That the Town of Grand Park, more particularly described as Township One Hundred Forty (140) Range Thirty-nine (39) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Becker County, is hereby dissolved and the territory of said Town is hereby annexed to the Town of Height of Land, more particularly described as Township One Hundred Thirty-nine (139) Range Thirty-nine (39) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Becker County.


