

ORDINANCE NO. 82

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF FINE RIVER IN INCORPORATING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED LAND NOT INCLUDING THE MAIN-ROAD AREA

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the village of Fine River, Minnesota, by the sole owner of the following described real estate to have such land included within the village of Fine River, Minnesota, said land situated wholly within the County of Cass and State of Minnesota, and described as follows:

All of Lot Five (5), and Lot Four (4) less that portion described as follows: commencing at the northeast corner of said Lot 4, thence running South Twenty-six (26) rods on the East line thereof to a point; thence West to Norway Lake; thence North along said lake shore to the Section line between Sections Thirty (30) and Thirty-one (31); thence East to the place of beginning. All of said land situated in Section Thirty-one (31), Township One Hundred thirty-eight (138), Range Twenty-nine (29).

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described, is sixty-four (64) acres.

Section 3. The village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village of Fine River, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 4. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1 and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 6. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 5.

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the village of Pine River, Minnesota, by the sole owner of the following described real estate to have such land included within the village of Pine River, Minnesota, and said land situated wholly within the County of Cass and State of Minnesota, and described as follows:

All of Lot Five (5), and Lot Four (4) less than portion described as follows: commencing at the North-east corner of said Lot 4, thence running South Twenty-six (26) rods on the East line thereof to a point; thence West to Norway Lake; thence North along said lake shore to the Section line between Sections Thirty (30) and Thirty-one (31); thence East to the place of beginning. All of said land situated in Section Thirty-one (31), Township One Hundred Thirty-eight (138), Range Twenty-nine (29).

Section 2. The quantity of land
