GUNN of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General on May 1, 1959, for the purpose of prosecuting an appeal in the Supreme Court of the State of Minnesota entitled State v. Legrand-Lull et al; that his compensation was set at \$6.00 per hour for preparation and \$300.00 for appearing and making oral argument; that said fees include all clerical and other necessary expenses incurred by counsel; and that said sum is to be paid out of the Trunk Highway Fund. 
