

A PROCLAMATION FOR "SUBMARINE VETERANS WEEK"

WHEREAS, the Submarine Veterans of World War II have formed a chapter that embraces the entire State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the Submarine Veterans of World War II, as an organization desire to perpetuate the memory of and pay tribute to, the heroic submariners that were lost during World War II; and

WHEREAS, the Submarine Veterans of World War II desire to further promote and keep alive the spirit and unity that existed among submarine crewmen during World War II;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning April 3, 1960 through April 9, 1960 shall be known as

"SUBMARINE VETERANS WEEK"
