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Section 19 of said City Charter is hereby amended by adding to said section at the end thereof the following proviso: PROVIDED, that when no more than two persons file for the nomination for any one office, their names shall not be placed upon the primary ballott, but said persons shall be concidered and shall be the nominees for such office and their names shall be placed upon the general municipal ballot as provided by section 24 of this Charter. PROVIDED, that when no more than two persons file for the nomination for any office, no primary election shall be held.

Section 70 of said Charter is hereby amended so as to read as follows: SECTION. 70- The fiscal year of the City shall commence upon the 15th, day of March, of each year, except when such date falls upon Sunday, in which case, it shall begin on the next succeeding business day.

Whereas a petition for the incorporation of the Village of Greenwald, in Stearns County, Minnesota, a true copy of which petition is hereto annexed, has been duly filed with and approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Stearns County, Minnesota,

Now Therefore, as provided by law, it is hereby ordered that an election be held of the voters of the territory described in said annexed petition for the purposed of voting upon the propostition of whether or not said voters are desirous of incorporation said territory as a Village, and it is further ordered that notice of said election be given by the posting of three copies of this notice, with a copy of said petition annexed thereto, in three public places within the boundaries of said proposed village, which said notices shall be posted in said territory not less than twenty (20) days prior to the date of the holding of said election as said date is fixed herein. PETITION.

To the Honorable, the Board of County Commissioners of Stearns County, Minnesota:

The undersigned legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, and which is herein sought to be incorporated as a Village, pursuant to Chapter nine of the General Statutes of Minnesota for the year 1913, and the amendments thereof, do hereby respectfully petition and show to your honorable body, as a basis for the organization of a Village, the following facts:

- 1. That the undersigned are all reisdents of the territory hereinafter described and are legal voters of the County of Stearns, State
 of Minnesota.
- 2. That the name of the village sought to be incorporated in this proceeding is "Greenwald".
- 3. That the quantity of land embraced in the territory sought to be incorporated as a Village is two thousand five hundred and sixty (2560) acres.
- 4. That the number of actual residents residing on said territory aforesaid is two hundred and nine (209) persons.

5. That the boundaries of the territory sought to be incorporated as a Village are as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter ($SW_{i}^{1}SW_{i}^{1}$) of Section t thirty-four (34), Township one hundred and twenty-five (125), Range thirty-three (33); thence West to the Southwest corner of Section thirty-two (32); thence North to the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter ($SW_{i}^{1}SW_{i}^{1}$) of Section thirty-two (32); thence West to the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter ($SW_{i}^{1}SW_{i}^{1}$) of Section thirty-one (31); thence North to the North east corner of the southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter ($SE_{i}^{1}SW_{i}^{1}$) of Section thirty (30); Thence west to the Northeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter ($SW_{i}^{1}SW_{i}^{1}$) of Section thirty (30);

Thence north to the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (NW SW SW) of Section thirty (30); thence East to the center of Section thirty (30); thence North to the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (NW NEt) of Section thirty (30); thence East to the Southeast corner of the northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter (NEWNET) of Section twenty-nine (29); thence North to the corner common to Sections twenty (20), twenty-one (21), twentyeight (38) and twenty-nine (39); thence East to the Quarter post between Sections twenty-one (21) and twenty-eight (28); thence South to the South west corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (NW NE NE) of Section twenty-eight (28); thence East to the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter (NET NET) of Section twentyeight (28); thence South to the Southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter (SE NEW NEW) of Section thirty-three (33); thence East to the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (NW+SW+) of Section thirty-four (34); thence South to the place of beginning; all of said territory being in Township One hundred and twentyfive (185) of Range thirty-three (33), according to the Government survey thereof.

6. That said territory so sought to be incorporated as a Village as aforesaid is situate in the County of Stearns, State of Minnesota, and that no part thereof is included in any incorporated village; that a portion thereof has been platted into lots and blocks and is known as the Townshite of Eslarn, which said plat of said Townsite of Eslarn has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota, and has been duly filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Stearns County, Minnesota, as required by law. That the unplatted portion of the territory outside of said Townsite of Eslarn adjoins said platted portion and is so conditioned as properly to be subject to Village Government.

Wherefore your petitioners respectfully pray your honorable body to approve this petition and to take such further proceedings for the holding of an election thereon and for the incorporation of said territory as a Village as the laws of the State of Minnesota require.
