A PROCLAMATION FOR "SEAWAY DAYS"

WHEREAS, the opening of the St. Lawrence Seaway has centered national and international attention on the cities of Duluth, Minnesota, and Superior, Wisconsin, the beginning of the Seaway; and,

WHEREAS, the possibility of increased tourist and industrial development in the states of Minnesota and Wisconsin is limited only by imagination; and,

WHEREAS, the citizens of Minnesota wish to join the Miss Seaway International Pageant, Incorporated, in its wish to extol and promote the growth of the St. Lawrence Seaway communities;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 6-15, 1960, as

"SEAWAY DAYS"

and urge every citizen of the state of Minnesota to participate and actively promote development of the states of Minnesota and Wisconsin and other Seaway communities.
