

**ORDINANCE NO. 443**

**AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND IN SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 124, RANGE 28, TO THE CITY.**

WHEREAS the Waldorf Paper Products Company, a corporation, has presented to, and filed with, the Council of the City of St. Cloud its petition requesting that the following described tract of land, situated in the County of Stearns, State of Minnesota, to-wit:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter lying southerly of the southerly right-of-way line of County-State Aid Road No. 4, and all that part of the East Half of the Southwest Quarter lying northerly of the right-of-way of the Great Northern Railway Company, all in Section 9, Township 124, North, Range 28, West, containing in all 50 acres of land, be annexed to and made a part of the City of St. Cloud; and

WHEREAS, after due investigation and consideration, it is hereby found, determined and declared:

1. That said above described tract of land adjoins and lies immediately adjacent to the corporate limits of the City of St. Cloud, and that no part thereof is within any municipality;

2. That said petitioner is the sole owner of said tract of land; that said land, and the whole thereof, is unplatted; that there are no buildings of any kind

thereon; and that no person or persons reside within the area thereof;

3. That said tract of land is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to municipal government; that the interests of the City of St. Cloud, of said land, and of the petitioner would be best served by the annexation of said tract of land to the City of St. Cloud;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CLOUD HEREBY ORDAINS:

That said above described tract of land be, and the same hereby is, annexed to the City of St. Cloud, Minnesota, and declared to be a part thereof.

Adopted by the Council of the City of St. Cloud at a special meeting held August 26, 1959, by the following vote:
