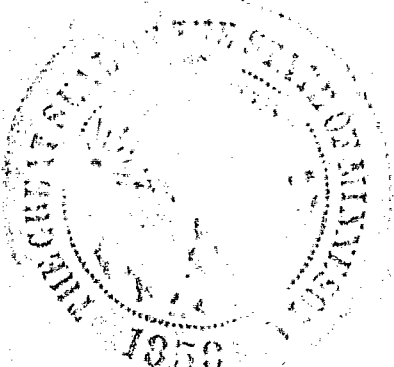
To Walter F. Mondale
