ORDINANCE NO. 4-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CONSTITUTIONAL EASES OF THE VILLAGE OF FOSTON TO INCLUDE THE ZONE AND LOCALIZED JURISDICTION.

Section 1. The Village of Foston is the sole owner of the real estate that is the subject of this annexation, and which is described in Exhibit "A" attached.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 16.46 acres.

Section 3. The Village Council hereby determines, that the annexation of the above described real estate will be to the best interests of the Village of Foston, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to Village government.

Section 4. THEREFORE, the Village of Foston, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village of Foston, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State and from and after its passage and publication.


