the Attorney General for the period commencing May 5, 1960, and to  
serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General, or until this commis-  
sion shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law;  
and I hereby fix the compensation of said CHARLES E. HOUSTON at the  
sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) per year, to be paid from  
the appropriation made for the Department of the Attorney General.
