KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, WALTER F. MONDALE, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Sec. 8.06, Minn. Stat. 1953, and upon the request of the Commissioner of Highways, do hereby constitute and appoint MILTON G. DUNHAM of Minneapolis, Minnesota, Special Assistant Attorney General, and fix his compensation in the sum of \$9500 per annum, to be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Fund. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1960.
