I, Edwin J. Kenny, Judge of the District Court of the Sixth Judicial District, having given notice to the Governor of my retirement from such office as of June 10, 1960, and being eligible for the benefits of the law providing retirement compensation for retired Judges, being Section 490.102, Minnesota Statutes, as amended by Chapter 688, Laws of 1959, do hereby elect that in lieu of the retirement compensation otherwise provided for by law, the retirement compensation for myself during my lifetime, and thereafter for my surviving widow during her lifetime, be paid as follows:

- (a) To myself, three-fourths of the retirement compensation I would otherwise have been entitled to under the laws applicable on the date of my retirement, and
- (b) Upon my death, to my widow, as hereinafter defined, one-half of the retirement compensation which I would otherwise have been entitled to receive during my lifetime had I not made such election.

I hereby certify and specify that the name of my wife is Mary S. Kenny, that her birthdate was March 31, 1888, and the date of our marriage was August 30, 1913.
