GUBBINS, Jr., of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General, to act as attorney for the Department of Employment Security of the State of Minnesota, for the purpose of preparing and submitting briefs to, as well as arguing orally before, the Supreme Court and taking any further action which is required in order to complete the necessary legal action with respect to Supreme Court cases involving the interpretation of the Minnesota Employment Security Law presently pending before the Supreme Court which had been commenced during the period when George C. Gubbins, Jr., was assigned to the said Department as an Assistant Attorney General, his compensation to be at the rate of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450.00) monthly, to be paid out of fund of said Department of Employment Security.

Said appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. This appointment shall be effective May 5, 1960.
