ORDINANCE NO. 98

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF ROSEAU, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Roseau, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described land, situated, lying and being in the County of Roseau, and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

The Southerly twenty-five (25) feet of even width of the following described tract: All that part of the North seventy-five (75) feet of the South Malf (S%) of Subdivision "D" of Riverside Subdivisions, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of Register of Deeds of Roseau County, Minnesota, lying and being Westerly of the Westerly boundary line of the public highway, commonly referred to as Riverside Avenue, extending in a Northerly direction across said Subdivision "D", and that the said described land contains less than 200 acres,

abutting upon the incorporated Village of Roseau, Minnesota, be and the same hereby is annexed to said Village, to become a part of said Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance is passed pursuant to a petition signed by all the owners of the above described real estate.

Section 3. That said real estate is so conditioned as to be subject to municipal government, and that annexation thereof will be for the best interests of said Village and said real estate.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, and the filing a copy thereof with the Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of said State of Minnesota.
