A PROCLAMATION FOR "MOBILE HOME WEEK"

WHEREAS, more than 70,000 of our citizens live in mobile homes in this state;

WHEREAS, these families spend nearly \$1 billion each year in the ordinary staples of family living; and,

WHEREAS, they are demonstrated to be good citizens, and an important part of our state life, taking part in social, religious, civic, and political activities; and,

WHEREAS, these good citizens are composed of a cross section of vocations, students of higher learning, doctors, attorneys, executives, artists, skilled and unskilled laborers, and the skilled - our scalper citizens; and

WHEREAS, the mobile home industry is clearly an important economic segment of our life in Minnesota;

NOW THEREFORE, I, *Orville L. Freeman*, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 1-7, 1960 as

"MOBILE HOME WEEK"

and urge all citizens to mark it well.
