of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General
to act for the said Minnesota State Board of Optometry. His
compensation shall be paid from and out of the funds of said
Board as is hereby fixed as follows: For such part time as
the Board may require, but not to exceed one-twelfth of his
full time, the sum of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) per month
and for such time as the Board may require in excess of such part
time for office services at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)
per day, and for services in court at the rate of Sixty-five
Dollars (\$65.00) per day.
