PETITION FOR INCORPORATION.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY BOARD OF PENNINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned, legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, do respectfully petition your Honorable Body to call an election for the purpose of incorporating the said territory as a village according to the laws of the state of Minnesota, said village to be known and designated as the village of Goodridge.

The territory proposed to be incorporated is as follows: The South Half of the Northwest Quarter ($S\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the North One-fourth of the Southwest Quarter ($N\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-one (21) Township Number One Hundred and Fifty-four (154) North of Range Forty (40) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in said County of Pennington and State of Minnesota.

In support of this petition we respectfully submit the following facts:

First: The townsite of Goodridge and all its additions and extensions is included in the territory proposed to be incorporated and same has been duly platted into blocks and lots and the plat thereof has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the state of Minnesota and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for the said County of Pennington;

Second: All that portion of the South Half of the North West Quarter ($S\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twenty-one (21) not included in said townsite of Goodridge, adjoins same on the North and is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to village government.

Third: All that part of the North One-fourth of the South West Quarter ($N\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twenty-one (21) included in said townsite of Goodridge, adjoins same on the south and is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to village government.

Fourth: The said property proposed to be incorporated includes one hundred ^{two}/₁₀₀ acres and is bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Quarter Section line eighty rods north of the center of said section twenty-one; running thence on said Quarter line south one hundred twenty (120) rods; thence west parallel with section line one hundred sixty (160) rods to a point forty (40) rods south of the Quarter stake on West side of said Section Twenty-one (21); thence North on West line of said Section Twenty-one (21), one hundred twenty (120) rods to a point eight (80) rods North of the Quarter post on West line of said Section Twenty-one (21); thence East, parallel with Section line, one hundred sixty (160) rods to place of beginning;

Fifth. That on the 8th day of July, 1915, we caused to be taken an accurate census of the above described territory proposed to be incorporated as a village and found the total number to be two hundred and twenty-three (223).

Sixth. No part of said territory is now or never has been incorporated as a village.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners in and for Pennington County, Minnesota, held July 12, 1915, Commissioner *Quibel* introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption, the same being duly seconded by commissioner *Peterson*:

Be it resolved that the petition to said Board to call an election for the determination of the proposed incorporation of certain lands situate in said County, described in said petition, as a village, to be known and described as the village of Goodridge, be, and the said petition hereby is by said Board approved, and, Be it further resolved that pursuant to said petition, an election be and the same hereby ~~will~~ is called, to be held on the 6th day of August, 1915, at Goodridge Hall, within the said proposed village of Goodridge, said county and State, between the hours of five o'clock A. M. and five o'clock P. M., at which time and at which election the qualified voters then within the territory described in said petition may vote upon the question of incorporating the said village in accordance with said petition, and, be it further resolved that John T.
