TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY BOARD OF PENNINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned, legal voters residing Within the territory hereinafter described, do respectfully petition your Honorable Body to call an election for the purpose of incorporating the said territory as a village according to the laws of the state of Minnesota, said village to be known and designated as the village of Goodridge.
