ORDINANCE No. 93

ORDINANCE CHANGING VILLAGE ELECTION DATE

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, Section 205.07 authorizes the council to designate the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November as the regular village election date,
AND WHEREAS, the council believes that this change in election date should be made by the village,
NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF EYOTA, MINNESOTA
ORDAINS,

Section 1. Commencing with the 1960 village election, the regular village election of Eyota, Minnesota, shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each year.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.


