YOU WILL PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, at a Regular Meeting on the 5th day of July, 1960, the Council of the Village of Fairfax, Minnesota, adopted the following Ordinance:

"ORDINANCE NO. 78

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE VILLAGE ELECTION DATE

WHEREAS, the law of the State of Minnesota authorizes the Council to designate the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November as the regular Village Election Date, and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that this change in election date should be made in this Village, and

SO THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF FAIRFAX, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

SECTION I

Commencing with the 1960 Village Election, the regular Village Election of the Village of Fairfax shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each year.

SECTION II

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.

Ordained, passed and ordered published by the Village Council this 5th day of July, 1960.

# Affidavit of Publication

scribers; has been entered as second class mail matter in the local post office  
of its said place of publication; that there has been on file in the office of  
the County Auditor of said county the affidavit of a person having first hand  
knowledge of the facts constituting its qualification as a newspaper for pub-  
lication of legal notices; and that its publishers have complied with all de-  
mands of said County Auditor for proofs of its said qualification.

That the printed Fairfax Standard  
hereto attached as a part hereof was cut from the columns of said newspa-  
per; was published therein in the English language once each week for 1  
successive weeks; that it was first so published on the 14 day of  
July 1960 and thereafter on Thursday of each week
