AN ORDINANCE
ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS
TO THE VILLAGE OF STEWARTVILLE

WHEREAS, a Petition of Annexation for certain land situate in the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 105, Range 14, Olmsted County, Minnesota has been presented to the Village Council of Stewartville, Minnesota, and whereas 30 days posted notice and two weeks published notice of the Hearing on the Proposed Annexation was had, and whereas the hearing on the proposed annexation was held June 6, 1960, at 8:30 P.M. in the Chambers of the Village Council;

AND WHEREAS, the Village Council of Stewartville, Minnesota, had determined that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Stewartville and the territory affected,

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF STEWARTVILLE, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following described lands are hereto annexed and made a part of the Village of Stewartville: That part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 105, Range 14, Olmsted County, Minnesota, lying East of the center of Root River and Creek and North of the South line of Wooldidge Street which is presently known as Third Street S.W., and South of the North line of Ormond Street which is presently known as Second Street S.W. in the Village of Stewartville if such lines were extended westward including all that portion of Dewey Avenue presently known as Seventh Avenue S.W.

2. The Village Clerk is hereby instructed to file a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the County Auditor and one in the office of the Secretary of State.
