
Dear Mr. Secretary:


If there are any further requirements for placing these names on the official ballot of your State as the nominees of the Democratic Party, please advise me.

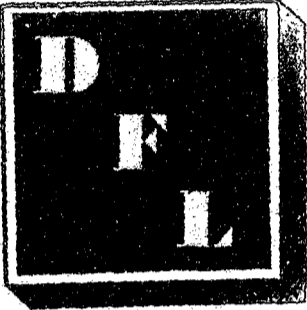


