

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Federal government will hold a wheat marketing referendum on July 21, 1960, to enable wheat producers to approve or disapprove wheat marketing quotas; and,

WHEREAS, all available economic information indicates that approval of wheat marketing quotas for 1961 will have a highly beneficial effect upon the economic condition of Minnesota's farm families who produce wheat; and,

WHEREAS, the depressed economic condition of agriculture in this great state is adversely affecting the welfare not only of our farm families, but also of the families who dwell within our cities and towns;

IN TESTIMONY, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, this day do hereby urge all Minnesotans to study carefully the merits of the wheat referendum, and to cast their votes in favor of passage of wheat marketing quotas.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty and of the State the one hundred third.
