ORDINANCE NUMBER 55 REGARDING VILLAGE ELECTION

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, Section 205.07 authorizes the council to designate the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November as the regular village election date,

AND WHEREAS, the council believes that this change in election date should be made in this village,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF Byron, MINNESOTA
ORDAINS

Section 1. Commencing with the 1960 village election, the regular village election of Village of Byron shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
