commemorates the achievements of the food processing industries  
that these accomplishments engendered from the time of Nicolas  
Appert and Peter Durand; and,

WHEREAS, canned foods have gained universal acceptance, due in large  
measure to the scientific research and engineering which the  
food processing and associated industries have conducted and  
which they have generously supported in industry, university,  
and government laboratories; and,

WHEREAS, the advancements in one industry have been accompanied by  
growth in the economic stature of the others; and,

WHEREAS, through constant attention to quality and through new product  
development, America and the world have been provided a  
dependable supply of pure, wholesome and nutritious foods; and,


WHEREAS, many of men and women throughout the State of Minnesota during  
their livelihood and devoting their productive efforts to the  
food processing industries are this year celebrating the one-hu-  
ndredth anniversary of the birth of a great industry and we  
desire that their fellow citizens should join them in the

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota,  
do hereby proclaim the week of August 21 to 27, 1960 to be


