WHEREAS, cooperative organization by individuals for the purpose of carrying on business and other lawful activities is a deeply rooted part of the free enterprise system; and,

WHEREAS, this cooperative tradition is particularly strong in the State of Minnesota; and,

WHEREAS, cooperative associations in our state have contributed substantially to agricultural progress and general economic development in Minnesota through their functions of providing for the processing and marketing of agricultural products and for the purchase of goods and services by consumers;

BY VENDEE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the ninth of October, 1960 as


"CO-OP NIGHT"
