A PROCLAMATION FOR "BETTER CITIZEN"

WHEREAS, THE ORDER OF BILLYGY IS a character-building organization that accepts any young man between the ages of fourteen and twenty-one, who will dedicate himself to attaining the high moral standards set by the Order; and,

WHEREAS, each member of the Order of Billygy vows to be a better son, to love and serve God and his country, to be courageous and faithful to his fellowmen, to honor and protect every woman, to practice tolerance towards others, to aid and uphold our public institutions and patriotic freedom, and to fulfill all obligations as upright and public-spirited citizens before God and man;

WHEREAS, each Chapter of the Order of Billygy is required to observe the following Obligatory Days: Parents' Day, Billygy Day of Comfort, Devotional Day, Educational Day, Parents' Day, and My Government Days; and,

WHEREAS, the Order of Billygy features state-wide projects such as Anti-communism, Antinarcotics, Civil Defense, Blood Donations, the Foot-Dry Safety Crusade, Civic Service and Vocational Guidance.

IT IS THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, recognizing the valuable contributions of this young man's organization, and by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby proclaim August 22nd through August 26, 1960, as

"BETTER CITIZEN"
