AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 100, AN ORDINANCE TO
REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 100.

The City Council of the City of Hutchinson hereby

ORDINANCE NO.

REPEALS the Ordinance of the City of Hutchinson, Minnesota, in the name of
the following described land, lying and being in the County of Deuel and State
of Minnesota, and described as follows to-wit:

A tract of land containing approximately 25/100ths of an acre which is
designated as tract "A" in Section 1, Township 115, Range 30, according to the
Index of Deeds of Deuel County, Minnesota, in Volume 1, page 10, of Deuel County
Records, and is approximately 1/2 x 1/2 mile in size, which land is more completely
described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the South line of the Northwest Quarter of
Section One (1), Township One Hundred Fifteen (115) North of Range Thirty (30)
West, 4.00 chains West of the Southeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter of
said Section One (1); thence West on the North line of said Northwest Quarter,
4 rods thence North 8 rods; thence East 4 rods; thence South 8 rods to the
place of beginning, being a part of Int. 22 Auditor's Plat of the part of the
Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 115, Range 30, lying South of the 1122
Road, according to the respective maps or plats thereof in the office of the
Register of Deeds for Deuel County, Minnesota.

SECTION II.

AND WHEREAS, said lands are situated outside of the City limits of the
City of Hutchinson but are contiguous to the said City limits and abut upon said
City limits and are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal
government.

SECTION III.

AND WHEREAS, the above named petitioners have petitioned the City
Council of the City of Hutchinson to annex the above-described lands to the City of
Hutchinson.

SECTION IV.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hutchin-
son that the lands described above be and they hereby are annexed to the City of
Hutchinson and from and after the date of passage of this Ordinance, said lands
shall become a part and portion of the City of Hutchinson with the same taxes
and effect as though originally a part of said City.
